Context and Purpose

KNOW: Knowledge in Action for Urban Equality (https://www.urban-know.com/) is an action-research project that seeks to generate transformative research and build capacity for innovation in public policy and planning that promotes urban equity. Led by the Development Planning Unit (DPU) from University College London (UCL), KNOW is a global consortium of researchers and partners from more than 13 institutions, working in nine cities in Asia, Africa and Latin America, including Lima. KNOW is funded by ESRC-UK under the Global Challenges Research Fund, for a period of four years (2018-2021).

As part of the closing of the project, KNOW-Lima is organizing a series of on-site workshops and virtual events to promote a space for theoretical and practical reflection that brings together local and international guests. The purpose of the virtual sessions is to share similar experiences of academics, practitioners, policy makers, NGOs, activists and citizens to contribute to a co-learning process, spread urban intervention strategies and public policy proposals to move towards greater equity at the local and metropolitan level.

Virtual sessions:

- S1 Food insecurity and pandemia
- S2 Social and care infrastructure
- S3 Co-production to reduce urban inequalities.

Program Format

The three virtual events of 90 minutes are proposed where presentations and a final discussion will take place. In these sessions, the invited speakers will present their recent work or research in a 5-minute presentation. Finally, there will be a 25 +/- minute dialogue between the speakers and 20 +/- minutes for questions and answers from the audience. This format allows for exchange of ideas and conversation during the 90-minute event. The events will have simultaneous translation in Spanish, English and Portuguese.
