The Department of Economics of the PUCP, within the framework of the Program to Attract Young Full-Time Professors (Tenure Track), opens its call for three (3) full-time Professor vacancies for March 2023 aimed at young professionals in Economics who have a Doctorate degree (PhD) and experience in documented research. Likewise, they must be interested in developing a teaching career line and be committed to the institutional mission of the University. Candidates must demonstrate the ability to produce high-quality research and must have completed their doctoral thesis or be in the final stage of their doctorate. Hired professors are expected to provide academic leadership in the Department of Economics at PUCP.

PUCP is a private, non-profit, liberal education-oriented, research-driven university developing rapidly into a center for serious scholarship. Since its inception in 1917, the University has made strides through global collaborative research, contextual and flexible curriculum, project-based learning, and industry linkages; thus offering a unique learning environment and opportunity. ## Requirements

1. Doctoral degree (PhD) obtained within the in the last 5 years.
2. Doctoral degree (PhD) revalidated by the Peruvian Superintendence of University Education (SUNEDU) at the date of signing the contract.
3. Preferably under 40 years of age.
4. It is desirable that the candidates have teaching experience.
5. The selected candidates must teach the equivalent of 10 teaching hours per year.
6. The selected candidates must carry out undergraduate and/or postgraduate thesis advising.
7. High-quality academic production indexed in Scopus, Web of Science (Clarivate) or similar databases according to the specific conditions mentioned in the Bases.
8. The selected candidates must disclose their research in academic conferences refereed by an international scientific committee using the Department of Economics of the PUCP as affiliation. It is requested that selected candidates participate in at least one annual congress/meeting on average; congresses/meetings can be virtual or face-to-face.
